- Mackinac Bridge: Suspension bridge connecting the Upper and Lower Peninsulas (~3.5 hours).
- Mackinac Island: Island and resort area in Lake Huron (~3.5 hours).
- Thunder Bay National Marine Sanctuary: Shipwreck and water sanctuary in Alpena (~5 hours).
- Pictured Rocks National Seashore: Breathtaking Lake Superior Shoreline (~7 hours).
- Porcupine Mountains: Group of small mountains in the northwestern Upper Peninsula (~10 hours).
